



## How To Prepare For The Service



KITCHEN AND BATHROOM

In areas where ants are seen and in particular the kitchen, empty lower cupboards, and bottom of pantry.

Clear out all items from your cabinets and sink vanity drawers.



EXTERIOR OF THE HOME

Move planters, patio furniture, etc. 12 inches away from the outside walls.

Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture.



LIVING ROOM, BEDROOMS, GARAGE, ETC

In areas where ants are seen, move furniture 12 inches away from the walls.

Be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move large furniture.

Clear closet floors and shelves of shoes and other items. Clothing on hangers may be left in place.

After The Treatment
The bait and spray treatment will remain effective only if the following steps are taken after your home is serviced:
☼ DO NOT use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near bait placements or spray treatments, as this will decrease effectiveness.
Remove all competing food sources (this means keeping all foods in tightly sealed containers, cleaning up spills as they occur, removing trash on a regular
Reminder
It is necessary for you and your pets to leave your home for 4 hours once the treatment begin
Fish aquariums may be left onsite; however, they should be covered, and air filters must bed is connected.
Persons with underlying health conditions should consult their family physician where the have concerns regarding re-entry time.
Upon re-entry, please open windows for 20 minutes to properly ventilate the treated rooms.

- A complete interior and exterior inspection will take place to locate any nests. Your Technician will use a variety of methods to control the carpenter ants depending on each unique situation. Sometimes it is necessary for the technician to drill small pilot holes into walls to access a carpenter ant nest.
- Liquid sprays, dust and/or bait stations may be used. Bait stations should never be moved or tampered with. You will be contacted for your next scheduled inspection and treatment. All treatments will be made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.
