

Rodent Treatment

For our company to provide the most effective and safe service possible, we ask you to review and complete all the necessary steps listed below.



How to Prepare for the Service

Do not remove rodent droppings from any areas before inspection, this will allow the technician to determine activity, population, etc.

KITCHEN & BATHROOM



Empty only the ground-level cupboards and drawers of all dishes, pots, pans, cans, food, etc. and make sure pet food is secured in sealed heavy-duty plastic containers.



BASEMENT & CRAWLSPACE

Remove any obstacles near or around the access door, electrical panels, furnace units, and air exchange units.



BATHROOM

Clear out all items from your cabinets and sink vanity drawers.



ATTIC

Remove any obstacles near or around or leading to the attic access door.

GARAGE



Remove any obstacles on the ground level near or around the inside walls.

The garage should be free of any vehicles before the pest inspection.



LAUNDRY ROOM

Remove any obstacles near or around laundry machines.

After the Treatment

The control program will remain effective only if the following steps are taken after your residence is serviced:

- DO NOT move any of the stations or traps.
- DO NOT use any other rodent control products (this can work against the control measures put in place).
- Follow the technician's recommendations for any repairs needed to close entry points.
- Remove all competing food sources (this means keeping all pet foods in tightly sealed containers, cleaning up spills as they occur, removing the trash regularly, etc.).
- If you are not on a recurring pest prevention program, our technician will return after the rodent activity has been resolved to remove all baits and traps.

Allergen Notification

Some of the products we may utilize during our treatment may contain allergens such as wheat, soy, peanuts, and shellfish. Please alert your technician, property management, landlord and/or superintendent where concerns over allergens exist before the treatment.

Reminder

You or your pets don't need to leave your home before, during, or after the treatment. However, children and pets must not be in the same room/area during the treatment.

Please be patient. Depending on the infestation level and species of rodent, the treatment can take a period of time.

What You Can Expect from the Treatment

Your technician will use a number of methods to control the pest depending on each unique situation. Please do not move or tamper with any traps, monitors or products applied by your technician.

These have all been strategically positioned to maximize their effectiveness. All treatments are made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.
