



CLIENT PREPARATION FORM

In order for our company to provide the most effective and safe service possible, we ask that before our arrival you review and complete all the necessary preparations listed below.



How To Prepare For The Service



BASEMENT & GROUND FLOOR (if this is the area of concern)

- Move all furniture 12 inches away from the walls. Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture.
- Clear all closet floors and shelves of shoes and other items. Clothing on hangers may be left in place.



EXTERIOR OF THE HOME

- Move all planters, patio furniture, etc. 12 inches away from the walls. Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture.
- Remove items and debris from moist dark areas such as porches, in window wells, around rock gardens etc. to allow access for the Technician.

## After The Treatment

- DO NOT use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near spray treatment, as this will decrease or eliminate their effectiveness.
- Eliminate the leaf litter from the exterior perimeter.
- Some treatment may leave streaks on the outside windows; refrain from cleaning the windowsills but the glass can be cleaned with a damp cloth & warm water. (Please be sure to exercise safety first and use rubber gloves when cleaning the spray treatment).
- Remove any insect remains and vacuum appropriately.

## Reminder

- For interior treatments, it may be necessary for you and your pets to leave your home for 4 hours once the treatment begins.
- Fish aquariums may be left on site; however, they should be covered, and air filters must be disconnected.
- Persons with underlying health conditions should consult their family physician where they have concerns regarding re-entry time.
- Upon re-entry, please open windows for 20 min to properly ventilate the treated rooms.

## What You Can Expect From The Treatment-

Your Technician will use a variety of methods to control the pest depending on each unique situation. Liquid spray will be used and is the most effective treatment to take control. All treatments will be made with your safety in mind to ensure your health.
