



Carpenter Ant Treatment

RESIDENT PREPARATION SHEET

For our company to provide the most effective, safe service possible, we ask you to review and complete all the necessary steps listed below.

How To Prepare For The Service

EXTERIOR OF HOME

- 🐜 Move planters, patio furniture, etc. 12 inches away from the outside walls.

INTERIOR OF HOME & GARAGE

- 🐜 The following only applies to areas where ants are seen
- 🐜 Empty lower kitchen cupboards, and bottom of pantry.
- 🐜 Remove all items from your bathroom cabinets and sink vanity drawers.
- 🐜 Move furniture 12 inches away from the walls.
- 🐜 Clear closet floors and shelves of shoes and other items. Clothing on hangers may be left in place.

Reminders Before & After The Treatment

- 🐜 **DO NOT** use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products anywhere near bait placements or spray treatments, as this will decrease effectiveness.
- 🐜 Remove all competing food sources (this means keeping all foods in tightly sealed containers, cleaning up spills as they occur, removing trash on a regular basis.
- 🐜 When a spray is applied in your home, **you and your pets will be required to vacate for a 4-hour window** once the treatment begins.
- 🐜 Fish aquariums may be left onsite; however, they should be covered, and air filters must be disconnected.
- 🐜 A complete interior and exterior inspection will take place to locate any nests. Your Technician will use a variety of methods to control the carpenter ants depending on each unique situation. Sometimes it is necessary for the technician to drill small pilot holes into walls to access a carpenter ant nest.
- 🐜 Liquid sprays, dusts and/or bait stations may be used. Bait stations should never be moved or tampered with.
